1.00 PURPOSE

The purpose of this guideline is to outline the full range of requirements for the Surveyor of the Year Award, Meritorious Service Award, Sustaining Member Award, and Article of the Year Award. The selection of these awards must be complete 1 month prior to the Nevada Association of Land Surveyors Annual Conference. In the case of any of these awards, there is not a necessity to make an award every year if there are no qualified candidates.

- 4.00 MERITORIOUS SERVICE AWARD
- 5.00 SUSTAINING MEMBER OF THE YEAR AWARD
- 6.00 ARTICLE OF THE YEAR AWARD
- 7.00 ANNOUNCEMENT AND RECOGNITION OF AWARD RECIPIENTS
- 8.00 GUIDELINES APPROVAL

3.00 SURVEYOR OF THE YEAR (maximum of one award per year)

- 3.01 The recipient of this award should be a past or present state officer, chapter representative and/or chairperson of a Standing or Ad Hoc Committee.
- 3.02 As an officer, chapter representative, or a committee chairperson, the person selected should have shown distinguished leadership qualities related to getting others to participate in committee activities that produce results which are beneficial to the association.
- 3.03 The recipient may not be a past recipient of the Surveyor of the Year Award.
- 3.04 The current Chapter Presidents shall serve as the committee to select the Surveyor of the Year.

4.00 MERITORIOUS SERVICE AWARD (maximum of two awards per year)

- 4.01 Meritorious means: Admirable, commendable, exemplary, praiseworthy, deserving honor and recognition, etc.
- 4.02 Service means: Work by one person or group that benefits another.
- 4.03 Award means: To grant as merited or due, something awarded or granted.
- 4.04 The recipient(s) of this award should be a past or present state officer, chapter representative, and/or chairperson of a Standing or Ad Hoc Committee, or a member in good standing of the Nevada Association of Land Surveyors who is active in the association.
- 4.05 The recipient(s) may have demonstrated these qualities in the past and may not have been recognized.
- 4.06 The current Chapter Presidents shall serve as the committee to select the Meritorious Service Award(s).

5.00 SUSTAINING MEMBER OF THE YEAR AWARD (maximum of one award per year)

- 5.01 The Sustaining Member of the Year award is to recognize the significant contributions that our sustaining members make to NALS and the profession in general.
- 5.02 The Sustaining Member of the Year should be a strong supporter of NALS in terms of participation in NALS activities and functions, contribution of resources or equipment, and support of NALS and the surveying profession.
- 5.03 Eligible individuals or firms are those within the profession, directly allied with the profession or supplier of equipment and instrumentation, software or allied services to the profession.
- 5.04 The editor of the *Nevada Traverse* with the assistance of the current Chapter Presidents and the prior year Conference Chairman shall serve as the committee to select the Sustaining Member of the Year.

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6.00 ARTICLE OF THE YEAR AWARD (maximum of one award per year)


- 6.01 Authors must be involved in land surveying or a directly related field, or pursuing an education in land surveying.
- 6.02 The article must be previously unpublished.
- 6.03 The Article must be between 500 and 2,500 words on a subject directly related to land surveying or a related field.
- 6.04 There is no age, educational background, or Nevada residency requirements to receive the Article of the Year Award. Nevada resident land surveyors will be given preference.
- 6.05 The editor of the *Nevada Traverse* will select qualified articles and submit them to the committee. The editor, with the assistance of the current chapter Presidents and the State Scholarship Committee shall serve as the committee to select the Article of the Year Award.



7.00 ANNOUNCEMENT AND RECOGNITION OF AWARD RECIPIENTS

- 7.01 The recipients of these awards should be announced at the annual conference of the Nevada Association of Land Surveyors.
- 7.02 An article should be prepared and published in the Nevada Traverse for each award recipient. This will be the responsibility of the committee members. The article should cite the attributes of the person(s) or firm(s) selected for each award.
- 7.03 An article should be prepared and posted on the Nevada Association of Land Surveyors website for each award recipient. This will be the responsibility of the committee members. The article should cite the attributes of the person(s) or firm(s) selected for each award.
